Dear Parents and Carers,

I attended a meeting on Tuesday morning with representatives from the Department for Education and central government regarding additional funding for the Torridge region. This is part of the Government's 'levelling up' initiative. There were a few other heads and CEOs of Multi Academy Trusts present and the message we were all giving is that our rural setting does present a number of challenges for families living in the area.

Top was the lack of public transport followed by access to services such as doctors and dentists. Also high on the list was the lack of secondary school choice and sixth form provision. The point was made that neither GTS nor Holsworthy has a sixth form so post 16 education generally necessitates a long journey to Petroc or Exeter College.

I raised that access to sporting facilities can be a challenge if you don't have your own transport and that rising fuel costs makes it expensive to transport children to clubs.

While I doubt that we will suddenly see a range of new bus routes introduced to Shebbear or an astro-turf pitch for the community, it was good to be able to share some of the challenges faced when living in this locality.

Whether things will change following the newly announced General Election on July 4th is yet to be seen but there did seem to be a strong determination to invest in our local area to help address some of these pressing issues.
