Dear Parents and Carers,

I hope that you all had a lovely half term. It has been lovely to see the children back in school this week.

Yesterday we marked the 80th anniversary of D-Day by holding a whole school assembly. The operation back in 1944 cost many thousands of lives but ensured that we all enjoy freedom and liberty today.

I particularly focused on the fact that the soldiers were just normal people from places like Shebbear most of whom had never travelled that far – I heard one vetran talking about being there on the day and that it was first time in his life that he had ever been on a beach (he grew up in Nottingham).

I shared some then and now photographs and reminded the children that when we see older people, it is really easy to forget that that were young once and that getting old happens to all of us eventually. It was lovely to talk to some of the children afterwards and how positively they spoke about older people that they know and good to see the respect and understanding that they give them. They should be very proud of that.

I said that there was a good chance that many of the children will have relations (albeit fairly removed now) who were there that day or fought in one of the world wars. If you do have any further information about family members who may have served, we would love to hear about it so do encourage the children to let me know.

Attendance: For this week: 95.0%.

Teddy - 97.33%

After today there are just 31 school days until the end of the school year. Having undertaken our normal half termly attendance check I am pleased to say that 61% of pupils are in excess of 96% attendance for this school year including seven pupils who currently have 100% attendance. Being in excess of 96% attendance means the children will have missed no more than about seven days of school across a whole year. There are currently 14% of pupils (which is down I am also pleased to say) who are regarded as being persistently absent. This means that their attendance is below 90% so about 20 days of absence across the year or four school weeks.

Wherever your child is on the attendance front, there is still time to improve it (aside from those hundred percenters) by trying to avoid any further absences this school year. As a rough guide, two days of absence equates to a one percentage point drop in attendance.


School Photos: Hopefully you received the appropriate link and order details. Let us know if not.
